

How to Have God's Will in the Matter:

- God's Word Know the Word; Act on the Word.
- 2. <u>God's Principles</u> God is more concerned with who you are becoming (Character) than where you are. *Colossians 3:17, NKJV*
- 3. <u>God's Authorities</u> The main reason people don't go to their God given authorities is because of PRIDE.
- 4. God's Sovereignty We can't control the sovereignty of God.

Making Godly Decisions:

The answer to pressure is a **J**esus and our **pace**. Yoke with Jesus and He becomes our **partner** and our **peace**.

Miracles, Victories and Success

Nehemiah 1:11 NLT O Lord, please hear my prayer! Listen to the prayers of those who delight in honoring you. Please grant me success today by making the king favorable to me. Put it into his heart to be kind to me." In those days, I was the king's cup-bearer.

Fasting for Spiritual Breakthrough

Isaiah 58:5 NKJV "Is it a fast that I have chosen, A day for a man to afflict his soul (bring about a burden)?

The Key to Spiritual Breakthrough:

Have a burden that is great. Activate the burden by fasting on purpose with a purpose. It's our way of coming to God for the answers and relief needed.

Nehemiah 1:4 NKJV "So it was, when I heard these words, that I sat down and wept, and mourned for many days; I was fasting and praying before the God of heaven."

1 John 5:14-15 NKIV "Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him."

Do you have a burden, problem or fear that you need to fast and pray about? There are many types of fasting, simply put, fasting is giving up something you love for something or someone you love more!

Five Steps to Activate a Miracle

Nehemiah 1:5 NKJV And I said: "I pray, Lord God of heaven, O great and awesome God, You who keep Your covenant and mercy with those who love You and observe Your commandments.

Five steps to activate a miracle:

- 1. Realize what the problem is.
- 2. Recognize who God is-Great and Awesome
- 3. Repent of your sin.
- 4. Remind God of His promises—pray God's promises back to Him.
- 5. Request God's Favor.

Psalm 139:23 NKJV Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties;

Ephesians 3:20 NKJV

Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us,

Hidden Principles of Favor with God and Those Over You

Nehemiah 2:5, NKJV

Our attitude and action releases the favor of God and those in authority over us.


Positive Attitude People

What most people call a problem, positive attitude people often see as opportunities. They will attempt things that others will not. They will make decisions based on who God is—not what He is doing They will attract and influence others to go further faster than they ever dreamed.

We can't expect the blessings of God until we express an attitude of gratitude.

Prayer + Planning + Performance = Privilege, Promotion, and Progress (Favor of God and others)

Opposition to Opportunity


Ester 4:13 NKJV he sent back this answer: "Do not think that because you are in the king's house you alone of all the Jews will escape.

Esther 4:14 NKJV "For if you remain completely silent at this time, relief and deliverance will arise for the Jews from another place, but you and your father's house will perish. Yet who knows whether you have come to the kingdom for such a time as this?"

We can have God's provisions and protection and still have opposition. Opposition is from the devil trying to discourage and defeat you. God wants to take opposition and drive it into the greatest opportunity in your life.

When we change our perspective on who God is instead of the opposition we get God's divine destiny, power, purpose, protection and provision for our life. Who knew what you see as **opposition** is nothing more than God giving you the greatest **opportunity** of your life?

What opposition are you facing that might be God's opportunity to use you? God has you where you are to be used for such a time as this!



Identity Crisis

Nehemiah 4:1-2 NLT Sanballat was very angry when he learned that we were rebuilding the wall. He flew into a rage and mocked the Jews, saying in front of his friends and the Samarian army officers, "What does this bunch of poor, feeble Jews think they're doing? Do they think they can build the wall in a single day by just offering a few sacrifices? Do they actually think they can make something of stones from a rubbish heap—and charred ones at that?"

Sanballat Had an Identity Crisis

When people mock and make fun of others, they are having an identity crisis. They are trying to find their identity in being bad. They are trying to find identity in the people they are with. When people mock us, talk about us, make fun of us and we get upset and over react, we are having an "Identity Crisis"

When we get our *identity* from Christ we don't make fun of others and we don't over react.

Is there someone you have been making fun of that you need to ask God to forgive you? Are you upset because of what somebody said about you or the way you look?

P.S. Make sure you are more concerned about what God says about you than what others have to say about you!

Vision

Habakkuk 2:2-3 NIV Then the Lord answered me and said: "Write the vision And make it plain on tablets, that he may run who reads it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time; But at the end it will speak, and it will not lie. Though it tarries, wait for it; Because it will surely come, It will not tarry"

All visions start with a burden. Vision needs to be clear and written down—it has an end in mind. Without vision, you go back to your past. Vision gives you the discipline/restraint to keep going.

Vision Requires

- Teamwork Teamwork makes the dream work!
- More effort halfway.
- An awareness of weakness and vulnerability.
- Our refusal to be distracted.

A New Day of Mercy

The greatest picture of *God's Mercy* is the day God sent His Son Jesus Christ to die for our sins. The *Greatest Miracle* is the day Jesus rose from the grave! If we stop covering our sins, we will prosper and God will show us mercy! If we ask forgiveness for our sins, God will forgive us instead of judgement! God's mercies are new every day!

Proverbs 28:13 NKJV "He who covers his sins will not prosper, but whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy."

Lamentations 3:22-24 NKIV Through the Lord's mercies we are not consumed, Because His compassions fail not. **They are new every morning**; Great is Your faithfulness. "The Lord is my portion," says my soul, "Therefore I hope in Him!"

Thank God for His mercy being new every morning! God wants to forgive us and give us a new start every morning!

Process of Miracles

To have a miracle in your life, you have to have a problem. You have to be willing to listen to those trying to help you. The right counsel will always encourage you to follow God's will, not your feelings or emotions.

You have to be willing to do something about your problem. If you don't move; God won't move. Without God, you cannot; without you, God will not.

Listen to God's Word and apply it. God will do a supernatural miracle in your life.

2 Kings 5:1-3 NKJV

Now Naaman, commander of the army of the king of Syria, was a great and honorable man in the eyes of his master, because by him the Lord had given victory to Syria. He was also a mighty man of valor, but a leper. And the Syrians had gone out on raids, and had brought back captive a young girl from the land of Israel. She waited on Naaman's wife. Then she said to her mistress, "If only my master were with the prophet who is in Samaria! For he would heal him of his leprosy."

2 Kings 5:10 NKIV And Elisha sent a messenger to him, saying, "Go and wash in the Jordan seven times, and your flesh shall be restored to you, and you shall be clean."

Don't be Miserable Enjoy God's Mercy

Steps to Enjoy God's Mercy

- Keep recalling/reminding yourself what mercy is. Mercy is undeserved forgiveness and unearned kindness. Mercy is being pardoned from the punishment we deserve.
- 2. Practice receiving and giving mercy or we will be miserable.

Jesus did not come to *condone* sin or *condemn* the sinner—He came to *change* the sinner! Satan uses condemnation to drive us away from God. Mercy brings us back to God.

Benefits of God:

- 1. Salvation
- Mercies of God Practice the mercies of God.
- 3. Hope
- 4. Abundant Life
- 5. God's Mercies will always outweigh your sin.

Romans 12:2 KIV "and do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of the mind that you may prove what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of God."

We Need God's Mercy When We Mess Up

Genesis 13:8-9 NKIV "So Abram said to Lot, "Please let there be no strife between you and me, and between my herdsmen and your herdsmen; for we are brethren. 9 Is not the whole land before you? Please separate from me. If you take the left, then I will go to the right; or, if you go to the right, then I will go to the left."

The hardest people to show mercy to is those closest to you. The most mature person is the first one to *acknowledge* and take *action* when there is a problem. Lot was looking at earthly *opportunity* instead of *obedience*. How you deal with disagreements with those closest to you will determine the relationship you have with them.

The first sign of immaturity is when you think you are smarter than God. Problems we encounter sometimes are nothing more than a process God allows to teach us to handle His promises. *Prosperity* without *process* equals *pride*.

From Backsliding to Boldness

Our purpose will greatly determine our priorities in life

Matthew 4:19 NKJV "Then He said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men."

Matthew 14:27-32 NKJV "But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, "Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid. "And Peter answered Him and said, "Lord, if it is You, command me to come to You on the water." So, He said, "Come." And when Peter had come down out of the boat, he walked on the water to go to Jesus. But when he saw that the wind was boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink he cried out, saying, "Lord, save me!"And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, and said to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" And when they got into the boat, the wind ceased.

Lessons to Learn from the Storms of Life

Storms will come. Jesus is always with you. Focusing only on having our needs met is nothing more than camouflage by the enemy for us to live in the chaos. Acknowledging our weakness in the storm is the first step to true strength.

Our Purpose in Life

Matthew 16:24

We Need God's Mercy & Miracles When We Mess Up. Don't Faint When You Can Have Faith!

John 5:5-6 $_{\text{TLB}}$ "One of the men lying there had been sick for thirty-eight years. When Jesus saw him, and knew how long he had been ill, He asked him, "Would you like to be well?"

Conforming to what we believe we can't do, instead of believing what God says about us limits the power of God in our life. When we believe what God says about us, we live in His blessings instead of the burdens we brought on ourselves. Limited expectation on ourselves and God limits God instead of releasing Him in our lives.

God can radically change and cure, not simply comfort, us when we surrender to Him. Transformation takes place in participation.

Misery to Mercy

Lamentations 3:21-23 NKJV

This I recall to my mind, Therefore I have hope. Through the Lord's mercies we are not consumed, Because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness.

Mercy is the manifestation of God actively on behalf of His people freeing us from slavery, guilt, and punishment. Divine mercy of God is the unchangeable character of God—by which He does not take pleasure in the death of the wicked. Feelings of hopelessness and helplessness brings discouragement.

God's Word never lies and there is hope in the Lord. The devil will remind you of what you've done and condemnation will drive you from God. However, God wants to give us a fresh start every day. God's mercies will always outlast our sins. Without God's mercies, we will miss out on His miracles and our life will be miserable.

Psalm 51:1 NKIV To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David when Nathan the prophet went to him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba. Have mercy upon me, O God, According to Your lovingkindness; According to the multitude of Your tender mercies, Blot out my transgressions.

Sin brings guilt, MERCY brings freedom from that guilt!

Crisis to Calmness

2 Kings 4:1-7 TLB

Now the wife of the son of one of the men who tell what will happen in the future cried out to Elisha, "Your servant, my husband, is dead. You know that your servant honored the Lord with fear. But the man to whom he owed money has come to take my two children to make them serve him." Elisha said to her, "What can I do for you? Tell me, what do you have in the house?" And she said, "Your woman servant has nothing in the house except a jar of oil." Then he said, "Go around and get jars from all your neighbors. Get empty jars, many of them. Then go in and shut the door behind you and your sons. Pour the oil into all these jars, and set aside each one that is full." So she went from him and shut the door behind her and her sons. They took the jars to her, and she poured. When the jars were full, she said to her son, "Bring me another jar." And he said to her, "There is not one jar left." Then the oil stopped flowing. She came and told the man of God. And he said, "Go and sell the oil and pay what you owe. You and your sons can live on the rest."

Everybody expriences crisis, but not everybody knows the steps to being calm during the crisis.

Crisis + Choices = Calmness or Chaos

Crisis is a concealed camouflaged miracle waiting for us to obey God. The greatest problem with crisis is we look to human solutions for spiritual problems. Explore biblical principles to apply to the problem.

What we are doing before the crisis comes matters; serving and loving the Lord before the crisis will determine the outcome. Many times, it takes a crisis to prepare our hearts to hear from God.

Steps to Overcoming the Crisis

- Fix our eyes on the Rock—cry out to God.
- Quickly choose to humble ourselves to the mighty hand of God.
- Believe God is bigger than our crisis.

Raising the Bar on Relationships

Luke 7:36-38 "Now one of the Pharisees invited Jesus to have dinner with him, so he went to the Pharisee's house and reclined at the table. When a woman who had lived a sinful life in that town learned that Jesus was eating at the Pharisee's house, she brought an alabaster jar of perfume, and as she stood behind him at his feet weeping, she began to wet his feet with her tears. Then she wiped them with her hair, kissed them and poured perfume on them."

When people see you, what Jesus do they see?

- Be an imitators of Jesus.
- Follow His example.
- Walk continuously in love.
- Value one another.
- Practice empathy and compassion.

Our relationship with God is the foundation that every other relationship is built on. Relationship with Jesus starts with brokenness and desperation and ends with forgiveness. No matter what someone has done, Christ welcomes them. At this time we take the person Jesus to those who are hurting, broken and lost who need a SAVIOR.

Finding our Purpose

Matthew 28:18-20 KIV "And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Gotherefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Finding our purpose decreases stress and increases the power and presence of God.

Find God's purpose by doing life God's way and experience God's presence and power. Put aside our own selfish desires. Don't just go to church, *Be the Church*.

Ephesians 6:12 NIV "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers ofthe darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places."

The only real power Satan has over us is believing His lies.

The real enemy in our life is a spiritual battle.

Acts 1:8 NKJV "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

God's purpose for our life is to have Godly confidence and unbelievable courage. When we have that it will become contagious.

Raising the Bar on "Focus"

Luke 9:1-2 NKJV "Then He (Jesus) called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases. He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick."

We are to be a witness for Christ everywhere we go. The devil wants us to keep Christ quiet to prevent the Gospel from going forward. God wants to keep us talking!

Our FOCUS determines our direction.

If we focus on how big our God is, our focus will go from:

- Jealousy to Jesus.
- Crisis to Christ.
- Our mess to our Messiah.
- Stress to Blessed.

Don't allow our *lack* to get us off *track*! If Jesus calls us and sends us He will equip us! When we *keep our focus*—we will not only come to church, we will *"Be the Church."*

Anticipation + Participation = Expectations Met

Matthew 14:17-20 NKJV "And they said to Him, "We have here only five loaves and two fish. "He said, "Bring them here to Me." Then He commanded the multitudes to sit down on the grass. And He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, He blessed and broke and gave the loaves to the disciples; and the disciples gave to the multitudes. So, they all ate and were filled, and they took up twelve baskets full of the fragments that remained.

Raising the Bar on Manhood

1 Corinthians 16:13-14 TLB "Keep your eyes open for spiritual danger; stand true to the Lord; act like men; be strong; and whatever you do, do it with kindness and love."

P's of Men Who Have Not Raised the Bar on Manhood

- Passive allows wife to do everything; Adam was passive.
- <u>Persuaded</u> easily persuaded by the enemy and others; God has little persuasive power of them.

Godly Manhood

Raising the Bar on Wholeness

1 Thessalonians 5:23 MSG

"May God himself, the God who makes everything holy and whole, make you holy and whole, put you together—spirit, soul, and body—and keep you fit for the coming of our Master, Jesus Christ. The One who called you is completely dependable. If he said it, he'll do it!"

Two Things that Cause Us to Lack Wholeness

- 1. We treat the effect and not the cause. We have to treat the root.
- 2. Worry makes us feel worthless.

Our worthiness does not come from what we have done or have not done. Our worthiness comes from what Jesus did for us. We worry so much about tomorrow we miss the miracles and blessings for today. Focusing on tomorrow keeps our focus on the world instead of the Word.

Until you know you're not whole, you cannot be made whole. Wholeness can only come from God. Refocus on God's word and promises, you will be filled, full, and whole. Be willing to ask God what is the root problem in our life.

Do you understand what the root of your problem is? Many times, the root problem comes from genes and environment. What root problem could you have that come from gene's and environment? Did you experience a *conviction, challenge* or a *commitment* you need to make from this devotion?

From Broke to Blessed

Luke 5:1-7 NKN "So it was, as the multitude pressed about Him to hear the word of God, that He stood by the Lake of Gennesaret, and saw two boats standing by the lake; but the fishermen had gone from them and were washing their nets. Then He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to put out a little from the land. And He sat down and taught the multitudes from the boat. When He had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, "Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch." But Simon answered and said to Him, "Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless, at Your word I will let down the net." And when they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their net was breaking. So, they signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink."


To go from broke to blessed:

You have to get Jesus in the boat and use what you have. Don't miss the blessings of God because you are not allowing Him to use what you do have. He will ask us to do something contrary to what we believe. Are we going to live like the world or by the Word? Jesus is trying to prove to us that His way is always better than our way. It is not what He wants from us, it's what Jesus wants for us. Obey what Jesus says, not simply listen to what He ask.

James 1:22 NKJV "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.

When God is about to do a great work in our life, Satan will try to discourage us.

Do you have Jesus in the boat with you? Your life and problems? Is God asking you to do something is contrary to what you believe but based on God's word? Did you experience a *conviction*, *challenge* or a *commitment* you need to make from this devotion?



Guard Your Heart

3 John 1:2 Amp "Beloved, I pray that in every way you may succeed and prosper and be in good health [physically], just as [I know] your soul prospers [spiritually]."

Matthew 5:8 AMP "Blessed [anticipating God's presence, spiritually mature] are the pure in heart [those with integrity, moral courage, and godly character], for they will see God."

Proverbs 4:23 NIV

"Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it."

Our success and prosperity are determined by the condition of our heart, not our circumstances. The condition of our heart controls our life. It is most important to guard our heart.

When our hearts are not pure, it limits the power of God in our lives.

1 John 1:9 NIV "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."

Ephesians 4:31 NKJV "Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice."

Ask for forgiveness and learn to forgive. Un-forgiveness leads to hatred, jealousy, hard hearts bad attitudes and anger. Guard your heart and let the power of God be plentiful in your life.

What condition do you feel your heart is in today? What could you do to better guard your heart? Did you experience a *conviction*, *challenge* or a *commitment* you need to make from this devotion?



WEEK 28

Forgiveness

Forgiveness does <u>not</u> represent <u>weakness.</u> It is the portal (way) to power.

Forgiveness does not always mean reconciliation.

Romans 12:18 "If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men."

Forgiving does not always mean forgetting. Regret is when God uses what you've done so that you will not do it again. Guilt comes as conviction of sin, but stays with you as a result of not asking for forgiveness of sin. When living in a state of guilt and pity, we miss the power of God. Forgiveness does not always mean trusting the person again. Don't keep bringing up past hurt to hurt the one that hurt you—don't keep bringing up past hurts to continue to hurt yourself.

John 8:32 NKIV

"And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

Is there someone you need to forgive? Do you need to forgive yourself? Did you experience a *conviction, challenge* or a *commitment* you need to make from this devotion?



Little Faith Can Produce Great Results

FALSE: You can't have joy and peace in suffering.

In Acts 9, Jesus changed Saul to Paul and his calling was to suffer and go through affliction for Christ. Jesus suffered. He suffered and enjoyed the results that happened.

Matthew 5:10 NKIV "Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."

You can have joy in the midst of suffering. We will all suffer it just depends on how you handle suffering.

Deut. 29:29 NKIV "The secret things belong to the Lord our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law."

TRUTH: The cause of all suffering is Satan and sin.

Romans 5:12

Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned—

6 Types of Suffering

- 1. Betrayal of someone you love.
- 2. Physical Pain and Suffering.
- 3. Financial loss.
- 4. Disappoint in our loved ones that brings suffering.
- 5. Suffering for doing what's right.
- 6. The greatest suffering is loss of a loved one child or grandchild.

We never truly understand this suffering. There is some suffering and pain you will never completely get over it. Put your trust in Jesus Christ you will get through it.

Suffering can be so great we get stuck in the suffering. Satan wants us to curse God when we suffer.

6 Things We Can Do with Our Suffering and Pain

- 1. When suffering comes, don't blame God and run from God; run to HIM and trust Him.
 - **Proverbs 3:5** NKJV "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding"
- 2. Ask God to remove the suffering.
- 3. Ask God to give us strength and comfort during the suffering.

 2 Corinthians 1:3-4 NKJV "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, 4 who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any [a]trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.
- 4. Pray God's will be done and God be glorified.

 Matthew 26:39 NKIV "He went a little farther and fell on His face, and prayed, saying, "O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will."
- 5. Don't worship the suffering -Worship the Savior.
- 6. Remember this is not your home. We are only here for one reason, to further the kingdom of God.

WEEK 30

Rejection

The root of all rejection is misplaced identity. God wants to take your rejection and turn it into redirection. Trusting in God protects us.

Proverbs 29:25 NKJV "Fear of man will prove to be a snare, but whoever trusts in the Lord is kept safe.

Learning to handle rejection gives us an unmeasurable amount of peace. Peacemakers love those who reject them and make an effort to reconcile.

Matthew 5:9 NKIV

"Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.

People who reject you are actually rejecting the Prince of Peace not you. The key to overcoming rejection is to solve your own identity problem. Don't allow rejection to hurt you let it help you by learning to define and redefine who you really are in Christ.

Do you feel rejected? Do you really know who you are in Christ? Did you experience a *conviction*, *challenge* or a *commitment* you need to make from this devotion?



Your Calling or Craving

1 Samuel 3:1-6 NKJV

"Now the boy Samuel ministered to the Lord before Eli. And the word of the Lord was rare in those days; there was no widespread revelation. And it came to pass at that time, while Eli was lying down in his place, and when his eyes had begun to grow so dim that he could not see, and before the lamp of God went out in the tabernacle of the Lord where the ark of God was, and while Samuel was lying down, 4 that the Lord called Samuel. And he answered, "Here I am!" So, he ran to Eli and said, "Here I am, for you called me." And he said, "I did not call; lie down again." And he went and lay down. Then the Lord called yet again, "Samuel!" So, Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, "Here I am, for you called me." He answered, "I did not call, my son; lie down again."

How do I know if I'm following my craving or God's Calling? The work of the flesh is *your craving*.

God's Calling

When following your calling, you will have joy and peace. We are saved, called, anointed and appointed as children of God. When we are called, we don't walk, we run. Hearing from God, and not going through the process, we will never be used greatly by God. We will miss our calling because we are drawn to our craving—we can see physically well, but can't perceive what God wants them to do. We need to humble ourselves and hear from older, mature mentors and listen to what God has called us to do.

Do you feel that you are following God's call or your craving?

God's calling will bring fulfillment; while your craving will lead to emptiness.

What is God calling you to do? Did you experience a *conviction*, *challenge* or a *commitment* you need to make from this devotion?



Raising the Bar on "Problems

Our problems are a simple matter in the sight of the Lord.

2 Kings 3:18 NKJV "And this is a simple matter in the sight of the Lord; He will also deliver the Moabites into your hand."

If we are not spiritually prepared to handle problems, we will be defeated and discouraged.

John 15:5 NIV

"I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing."

John 15:7 NKJV

"If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you."


Many times, we blame God for our problems, we need to see Him as the answer to our problems.

Need to reverse your problem?

- 1. You have to know you have a problem.
- 2. Willing to admit you are part of the problem.
- 3. Dive into the Word and obey the Word.

The beginning of the answer to your problems is a need for a Word from God.

What's your greatest problem today? What's God's promise say about that problem? Are you willing to meet the condition of the promise? "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."



Holy Shift in Boldness

Acts 4:13 NKJV "Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus."


Boldness is:

- Taking advantage or creating opportunities to stand up for Christ.
- 2. Learning to address your biggest fear.
- 3. Deciding to say something when it would be easier to say nothing.
- 4. Bold application and confident assurance of who Christ is and who we are.
- 5. Proof that Jesus can take ordinary people and make extraordinary things.
- 6. Not about educated or non-educated, it's about being in the right position with the right person where it results in the right power.

We have the answers everyone is looking for.

We know Christ who can deliver, save and wants what is best for us. We need to stop being wimpy and be warriors for Christ. Everyone on this side of heaven owes everyone this side of hell an opportunity to go to heaven.

Holy Shift in Prayer

The longer something exist the easier it is to miss or shift away from the original intent, meaning, and purpose.

Acts 4:29-31 NKIV

"Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your Holy Servant Jesus. "And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness."

When the Holy Shift took place, we shifted from the Old Testament (laws and animal sacrifices) to the New Testament (Jesus paid the Ultimate Sacrifice). We shifted from limited power to unlimited power by the power of the Holy Spirit. Part of prayer is to shift from our benefit to being bold.

Prayer:

- Is we will start praying with boldness, speaking God's Word with boldness.
- Is not getting God to give us what we want, it'is getting God to give us what we need.
- Is not for God to remove our problems, hurts, and suffering, but to give us the power in the problem. The results give honor and glory to God in the problem. If we don't know that, we miss the power, presence and peace in the problem.

God is not worried about what we don't have. He wants us to use what we do have. The greatest shift in prayer is to understand that it's not always God's will to remove the problem and suffering, but to give us the power and presence to go through it to bring honor and glory to God.

Where do you need Gods power and presents today? When is the last time you spoke God's word with boldness? Did you experience a *conviction, challenge* or a *commitment* you need to make from this devotion?



Holy Shift in Power

Acts 3:19-20 NKJV

Abundant Life

"Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that He may send Jesus Christ, who was preached to you before,"

Unbelievable power of the Holy Spirit gives us the power to walk through our problems. Only Jesus can meet the needs in our lives. We cannot commit something to God and not obey. Sin will cost us.

How uncomfortable do we have to become with sin before we are willing to change and do what God has called us to do?

When we keep back from God, it limits the power and joy in our life. One of the ways to enter into the joy of the Lord is what we do with our talent, time, and money. What is it we need to be afraid of? Missing out on all that God has for us.

Holy Shift in Deacons

Acts 6:1-4 NKIV Now in those days, when the number of the disciples was multiplying, there arose a complaint against the Hebrews by the Hellenists, because their widows were neglected in the daily distribution. Then the twelve summoned the multitude of the disciples and said, "It is not desirable that we should leave the word of God and serve tables. Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business; but we will give ourselves continually to prayer and to the ministry of the word."

The original intent of the deacons is the same as every member of the church: to be ministers.

Deacons are to be servants. They are to care for the widows in the church. Deacons are to free pastors and leaders so they could give themselves to prayer, teaching and preaching.

Thed deacon ministry started out as a Biblical principle and turned into unbiblical tradition. Traditions are not bad unless they become unbiblical. How and where are you serving today? I believe every member is a minister!

Ephesians 4:11-12 NKJV

And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ,

Purpose and Passion
