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Accomplish an Abundant Life Boot Camp

4 Things you have to do to if you want the abundant life:

John 10:10, NKJV *“The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.”*

1 Corinthians 2:9, AMP *“But, on the contrary, as the Scripture says, What eye has not seen and ear has not heard and has not entered into the heart of man, [all that] God has prepared (made and keeps ready) for those who love Him [who hold Him in affectionate reverence, promptly obeying Him and gratefully recognizing the benefits He has bestowed].”*

#1 - You have to accept Jesus into your heart.

#2 - Love God.

#3 - Promptly Obey God.

#4 - Be grateful for what God has done.



Learn to Enjoy the Abundance.

#1 - Learn to enjoy abundant forgiveness.

Luke 7:47-48, NKJV

Therefore, I say to you, her sins, which are many, are forgiven, for she loved much. But to whom little is forgiven, the same loves little. Then He said to her, 'Your sins are forgiven.'

Luke 7:47, CEV

"So I tell you that all her sins are forgiven, and that is why she has shown great love. But anyone who has been forgiven for only a little will show only a little love."

#2 -Learn to enjoy abundant victories.

2 Corinthians 2:14, CEV *"I am grateful that God always makes it possible for Christ to lead us to victory."*

2 Corinthians 2:14, NKJV *"Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ."*

Romans 8:37, NKJV *"Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us."*

Romans 8:37, CEV *"In everything we have won more than a victory because of Christ who loves."*

#3 -Learn to abundant peace.

John 14:27, CEV

“I give you peace, the kind of peace that only I can give. It isn’t like the peace that this world can give. So don’t be worried or afraid.”

John 14:27, NKJV *“Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.”*

4 Things to Do Weekly To Have an Abundant Life

1 - Read and meditate on God’s Word.

Joshua 1:8-9, NKJV *“This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate (think on) in it day and night, that you may observe to do according (obey) to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.”*

If you don’t know where to begin, you can start by reading the book of John in the New Testament and Proverbs in the Old Testament, which is the book of wisdom.

Learn to ask good questions. For your preparation:

1. Is there any example for me to follow?
2. Is there any command for me to follow?
3. Is there any arrow for me to avoid?
4. Is there any sin for me to forsake?

5. Is there any new thought about God Himself?
6. Is there any promise for me to claim?
7. Is there any principle I must accept?
8. Is there a key word and what is the meaning of that word?

9 Things to Look for When Reading Your Bible:

S.P.A.C.E.P.E.T.S

1. S – Is there a Sin to confess?
2. P – Is there a Promise to claim?
3. A – Is there an Attitude to change?
4. C - Is there a Command to obey?
5. E – Is there an Example to follow?
6. P – Is there a Prayer to pray?
7. E – Is there an Error to avoid?
8. Is there a Truth to believe? Is there something you need to believe God for?
9. Is there Something to thank God for?

2. Go public: Being courageous is contagious; learn to talk about Jesus and tell others about Him.

Matthew 10:32-33, NKJV *“Therefore, whoever confesses (courageous before men) Me before men, him I will also confess before My Father who is in Heaven. But whoever denies Me before men, him I will also deny before My father who is in heaven.”*

Mark 8:38, NKJV *“For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him the Son of Man also will be ashamed when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels.”*

Romans 1:16, NKJV *“For I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.*

There is something about going public that allows us to experience the power of God in a special way. We don't need to try and force Jesus on others, but we can do it in the right way. We can invite them to church, pray for them if they have a need, tell them God has an abundant life for them, and share how they can have it.

#3 - Tithe immediately: The first 10% of your income.

“Yes, you should tithe,…”

Matthew 6:21, NKJV *“For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.”* ‘

This helps us not only obey God's Word but it also helps keep our hearts right. If you're having issues in life it's because something is wrong in the heart. Actions, behavior, and reactions come from the condition of the heart.

Proverbs 3:23, GW *“Guard your heart more than anything else, because the source of your life flows from it.”*

#4 - Serve


